Margaret MUTCH (1824-1884)

Margaret MUTCH, ¹ daughter of John MUTCH (1791?-1875) and Janet GIBSON (1794-1876), was born on 4 Apr 1824 in Peterhead, Aberdeenshire, Scotland. ² She was baptised on 10 Apr 1824 in Peterhead, Aberdeenshire, Scotland. ² She appeared in the census on 6 Jun 1841 in New Deer, Aberdeenshire aged 16. ¹ The address was: Nethermuire. She appeared in the census on 30 Mar 1851 in King Edward, Aberdeenshire aged 26. ³ The address was: Hill of Fishrie. On 30 Mar 1851 she was a Crofter in King Edward, Aberdeenshire. ³ She married **Thomas GREIG** on 3 Aug 1854 in Parish of Rathen. ⁴ She died on 20 Feb 1884 aged 59. ⁵ She had a relationship with **James KING** (no marriage record found).

James KING and Margaret MUTCH had the following children:

Janet R MUTCH (1848?-). Janet was born in 1848 (cal) in Tyrie, Aberdeenshire.³ She appeared in the census on 30 Mar 1851 in King Edward, Aberdeenshire aged 2.³ The address was: Hill of Fishrie. The census page definitely has R as her middle initial, but I believe the enumerator may have mistranscribed K for King, her reputed father being James King. Janet appeared in the census in 1861 in King Edward, Aberdeenshire aged 12.⁶ The address was: Over Brae.

Jane R MUTCH (1846?-1898). Jane was born in 1846 (cal) in Tyrie, Aberdeenshire.³ She appeared in the census on 30 Mar 1851 in King Edward, Aberdeenshire aged 4.³ The address was: Hill of Fishrie. The census page definitely has R as her middle initial, but I believe the enumerator may have mistranscribed K for King, her reputed father. Jane appeared in the census in 1861 in Fyvie aged 14.⁷ The address was: Wood Head. She married Alexander THOM in Nov 1863 in Fraserburgh, Aberdeenshire when he was 39.⁸ She appeared in the census on 2 Apr 1871 in Fraserburgh aged 25.⁹ The address was: 57 Back St. She appeared in the census on 3 Apr 1881 in Aberdeen aged 34.¹⁰ The address was: 48, Queen Street. On 3 Apr 1881 she was a General Servant in Aberdeen.¹⁰ She married William PIRIE on 26 Jul 1884 in Aberdeen when he was 37 and she was 38.¹¹ The address was: 6 Devanha Terrace. She appeared in the census on 5 Apr 1891 in Aberdeen aged 43.¹² The address was: 63 Commerce St. On 5 Apr 1891 she was a Shopkeeper in Aberdeen.¹² She died on 16 Dec 1898 in Aberdeen aged 52.¹³ The address was: 63 Commerce St.

Thomas GREIG was a Plasterer.
